

County-wide Propositions

Hood County Proposition A - This is a tax increase; the issuance of bonds in an amount not to exceed \$24,000,000 for renovation and expansion of the county's law enforcement center and jail and the levy of taxes sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds.

Hood County Proposition B - This is a tax increase; the issuance of bonds in the amount of \$125,000,000 for road projects and the levy of taxes sufficient to pay the principal and interest on the bonds.
